

PARKING FOR THE PENN STATE SCHOOL OF MUSIC VISITS AND EVENTS

We recommend parking in the Nittany Parking Deck, which is designated for visitors. It is only a short walk to the music buildings. Please be advised that it can close to visitors at peak times; in that case, the East or West Decks are both about a 10–15-minute walk from the music building.

Please note that you MUST PAY for parking at one of the kiosks located on the ground floor of the garage before returning to your car OR when exiting.

Other parking decks include:

West Deck Park Garage: West Deck, White Course Dr, State College PA 16801

East Deck Parking Garage: 1965 Bigler Rd, State College PA 16802

Note: Unless you have a handicapped permit, please do not park in the small lot directly adjacent to the music building on Allen Street; it is permit-only, and parking enforcement monitors and issues violations regularly. You may pull in there or park briefly with flasher for dropping off or picking up guests with limited mobility or students with large instruments.

The Nittany Parking Deck is located on Fischer Road, which runs adjacent to Park Avenue. Here is an interactive map for your reference: <https://transportation.psu.edu/nittany-parking-deck>. Additional information follows:

VISITOR ACCESS:

- Parking available seven days a week
- Payment required 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- No student parking 2 a.m. - 4 p.m., Monday - Friday, 2 a.m. - 4 a.m., Saturdays and Sundays
- No motorcycle parking permitted at any time
- Head-in parking only

\$2/first hour, \$1/hour for remainder	
Daily Maximum	\$16.00
Lost Ticket (per day)	\$24.00

Event parking rates may apply on certain dates. For event attendees without a valid Penn State parking permit, discounted prepaid parking for Bryce Jordan Center events and most Intercollegiate Athletics events is available at <https://psu.parkmobile.io> through 11:59 p.m. the night before each event. It is usually \$5.50 pre-paid or \$10 the day of the event.

ACCEPTED FORMS OF PAYMENT:

- Major credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover)
- U.S. Cash (No bills larger than \$20)
- U.S. Coins

HOW TO PAY:

- Take your ticket with you.
- Use pay station before returning to your vehicle.
- Submit paid ticket at any in-lane exit machine to exit.
- Important: Cash is not accepted at exit.

ACCESSIBILITY:

The music building is accessible. Many folks with family members with limited mobility or who use wheelchairs or who wish to drop off students with large instruments pull off next to building II in the adjacent parking lot to limit distance. There is accessible curb in the sidewalk (you'll see it on your right as you pull into the lot). Most doors have ADA-compliant buttons. Although most people prefer the entrance between music building I and II under the bridge as those are double doors and provide more clearance.

In the recital hall, wheelchair seating is to the right when entering (with the free-standing chairs). Please contact us so we may reserve seating for you in advance.

There are elevators in both buildings.
